ABOUT THE LEAGUE & THE MID-SOUTH CONFERENCE

The Super Y League (Super Youth League) is **supported by the professional league, USL** (the league the Tulsa Roughnecks play in).

WSA will play in the **Mid-South Conference** of the National Super Y covering the geographic footprint from South Texas to Kansas. This league platform is a Summer-Based competition platform.

The league's focus is summer competition, including **player scouting** networks to increase exposure of the top players in the country to scouts of the US National Team, NCAA College programs, and professional clubs.

The Super Y League supports **competition in the following divisions:** 13U, 14U, 15U, 16-17U, 18-19U.

OPPORTUNITY FOR THE ELITE YOUTH PLAYER AT WSA & SELECTION PROCESS BY CLUB TECHNICAL STAFF

The Super Y provides a great opportunity and platform for the elite level player at WSA to play inside a highly competitive arena, in front of top scouts from around the country, and also in a uniquely different environment than the player's primary WSA team.

The Super Y team at WSA has been built by Technical Director recommendations from various game evaluations over the course of the season. The players on each WSA Super Y League team will be matched with players from different community programs inside the vast network of WSA teams and player pools, creating another great experiential component to the event.

Each WSA Super Y League team is encouraged to be "pure-age" except in the Super Y combined divisions of 17U-16U and 19U-18U. The "pure-age" concept helps with the player scouting opportunities provided by Super Y. The WSA Super Y League teams will be coached by WSA Age Division Staff and supplemented by WSA Technical Staff. This year, the team selection is "team-based" instead of "player pool based".



DATES & TRAVEL FOR 2020: AUG 8-9 in DALLAS

Super Y will host all games on one weekend. This has made this a very economical venture for The Side.

The teams will **travel to Dallas on Aug 8-9 weekend to meet up w/ the South Texas and North Texas competition.** WSA will then play **host** to Arkansas and Kansas on the weekend of **August 15-16 in Tulsa, Oklahoma.** The third weekend of league play is TBD.

The competition for 13U-19U involves approx 2-3 games played in one weekend this year. Teams that win their conference championship will advance to the Super Y National Showcase in December. **The entire competition season works to minimally interfere with the player's entire primary team's season (NPL & OPC).**

COSTS & DEADLINES TO RSVP YOUR ROSTER SPOT - JULY 1 DEADLINE

Your roster spot is only available until July 20. Player wishing to RSVP for their roster spot must register by July 20. (see below) Technical staff has identified coaching staffs and teams to represent the club in this year's event. Team roster sizes will be: 11v11 - 18 players. Rosters may include 2 goalkeepers.

The cost to participate in the 11v11 Division has been *reduced* from \$195.00 to **\$125 for the 2020 seasonal year.** (payment plans are available to pay in 1,2, or 3 installments). To reserve a roster spot, the player must register and submit a \$50 deposit towards the \$125 fee.

*This fee includes: USL Player Registration Fee, USL Scouting Network, Player Insurance, Facility Rental, Super Y Team Entry Fee, National Entry Fees (if teams qualify). * Fee this year does not include coach travel, player's or team ref fees. Player's personal travel/lodging & food expenses are responsibility of the player.*
